Many home owners are heading into uncharted territory

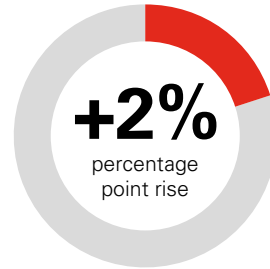


78% of mortgage holders have not experienced a rise in the interest rate of their mortgage/home loan in the time that they have had it

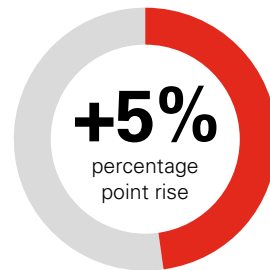
